TO: Lamoille County Project Neighbors

RE: PSB Docket No. 7032 – Lamoille County Project  
VELCO's Improved 115 kV Line Design from Duxbury to Stowe, Vermont.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

You are receiving this notice because your property is adjacent to or crossed by the right-of-way for this Project and you received earlier notice of the line design. On March 16, 2006, the Vermont Public Service Board ("Board" or "PSB") issued an Order and Certificate of Public Good approving the Lamoille County 115 kV Project (the "Project") as proposed by Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc. ("VELCO"), Green Mountain Power Corporation and the Town of Stowe Electric Department. On August 25, 2006, design plans were filed for the Project with the Board and concurrently notice was provided to you that such plans had been filed and were available at several locations or at your request for your review. The Board approved these plans in orders issued on March 9 and May 16, 2007.

Today, VELCO filed improved final engineering line design plans for the Project with the Board. As described in the filing letter to the Board, these plans contain certain improvements to the project design that are based on final engineering review. The following documents concerning the final line design have been provided today to all parties on the Docket No. 7032 Service List, to the Planning Commissions and Selectboards of the Towns of Duxbury, Waterbury (Town and Village) and Stowe, and to the Lamoille County and Central Vermont Regional Planning Commissions:

- Plan and profile for the final line design;
- Drawings of the structure types used in the final line design;
- Updated aesthetic mitigation plans that reflect the final line design and changes per landowner discussions;
- Memorandum from T.J. Boyle and Associates explaining the changes to the mitigation plans;
- Memorandum regarding the environmental impacts of the improvements;
- Chart identifying, on a structure-by-structure basis, noteworthy differences between the approved design and the final line design;
- Addendum to Hugh Henry's Above-Ground Historic Resources Report; and

- Memorandum from Hope Luhman and Niels Rinehart discussing the impacts of the improvements on archeological resources.
